## MOB CAP

### LIST OF NEEDED MATERIALS:

- 18" SQUARE OF FABRIC
- 68" OF 2" SINGLE EDGED LACE
- 1 YRD OF RIBBON


## MAID'S CAP

### LIST OF NEEDED MATERIALS:


- 14" SQUARE OF FABRIC
- 56" OF 1"-2" SINGLE EDGED LACE
- 1.5 YARDS OF RIBBON




① TAKE YOUR FABRIC AND FOLD INTO QUARTERS LIKE THIS.



CENTER →



② PUT THE PATTERN ON THE FOLDED FABRIC WITH THE "X" ON THE CENTER



AND CUT A CIRCLE USING THE LINE FOR YOUR TYPE OF CAP.

③ SEW A MILD GATHERING STITCH INTO THE STRAIGHT EDGE OF THE LACE TO EASE IT A FEW INCHES SMALLER



④ SEW THE →


EASED EDGE OF THE LACE TO THE OUTER EDGE OF THE FABRIC CIRCLE. ←


FOLD THE RIBBON IN HALF. MEASURE DOWN FROM THE FOLD 13" FOR A MOB CAP OR 8" FOR A MAID'S CAP.

PIN DOWN AT THE MEASURED DISTANCE TO MAKE A CIRCLE →

PLEAT OR GATHER THE CAP INSIDE THE CIRCLE OF RIBBON WITH PINS.





SEW THE CAP THROUGH THE RIBBON TO STABILIZE THE PLEATS OR GATHERS. REMOVE THE PINS.


SEW THE REMAINDER OF THE RIBBON INTO THE BOW.



